



AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION

between the

CYPRUS UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

and the

UNIVERSITY OF PAVIA

The purpose of this agreement is to promote co-operation in the fields of teaching and research between the **CYPRUS UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY** and the **UNIVERSITY OF PAVIA**.

Article 1

Both institutions will make every reasonable effort to encourage direct contact and research co-operation between their respective faculty members. Both Universities agree on the following general forms of co-operation:

- (i) Joint research activities
- (ii) Exchange of academic materials and academic publications and information
- (iii) Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures and discussions
- (iv) Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study and research
- (v) Co-organisation and participation in lectures, seminars and conferences

Article 2

The themes of joint activities, the conditions for utilising the results achieved and the arrangements of specific visits, exchanges and other forms of co-operation will appear as separate Addendums to the present agreement, and will be negotiated for each specific case by the interested parties.

Article 3

It is understood that all financial arrangements between the two Universities would be negotiated individually for each Addendum to this Agreement.

Article 4

For the practical realization of the agreement between the Graduate School of Civil Engineering of the University of Pavia, Italy, and the Department of Civil

Engineering and Geomatics of the Cyprus University of Technology, Cyprus, two coordinators are appointed:

- Professor Fabio Casciati from the University of Pavia, Italy
- Assistant Professor Christis Chrysostomou from the Cyprus University of Technology, Cyprus

The coordinators are responsible for the planning and realization of the activities of the agreement in accordance with the existing rules and practice of the institutions engaged in this program.

Article 5

It is also understood that the implementation of this agreement will commence upon its signing by both parties, and that it will be valid for five years, subject to revision or modification by mutual consent. The possibility and terms of renewal of their agreement will be discussed by the representatives of both Universities within six months prior to its termination.
